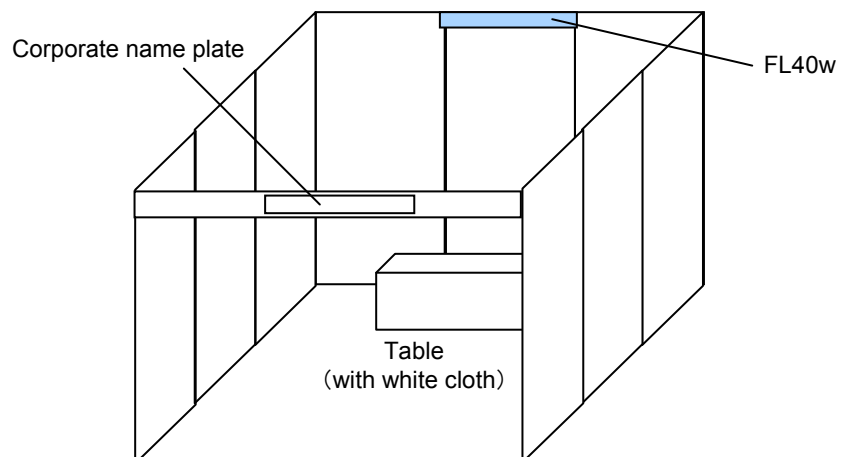

9. Invoicing of exhibition charge An invoice will be sent to the applicant after the organizer has checked the contents of its application.  
Please note that the application is accepted officially only upon receipt of the exhibition charge by the organizer.

10. Rejecting / suspending exhibition If the organizer considers that exhibits are not in line with the purport of the exhibition, it may reject the application. If that is the case, please honor the organizer's such decision.

11. Changing / calling off exhibition  
The organizer can change the period and/or opening hours of the exhibition or call off the exhibition, if it considers it necessary to do so due to a compelling reason such as an act of God.  
If the exhibition is called off, the exhibition charges will be refunded, but please note that the organizer is not liable for any costs incurred by exhibitors before such decision.

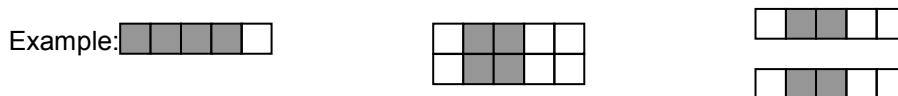
